Batik patterns are made by **resisting** the dye.

Fabric can be joined together by a needle and thread.

This can be done by hand or by sewing machine.

Dye can be used to change the colour of fabric.

There are different ways of joining fabric using a needle and thread. You can use a **running stitch** where you pass the needle in and out of the fabric.



Key Vocabulary

comfortable	When something feels nice and makes you relaxed.
dye	Dye can change the colour of fabric.
evaluate	Saying what you like about a product and what can be better next time.
needle	A long thin piece of metal with a point at one end, and a hole (or eye) at the other end.
resist	When something tries to stop another thing from happening. The wax stops the dye from sticking. The wax resists the dye.
secure	When things are joined together well so they don't move.
thread	Long, thin material that is used to make fabric or join fabric together.
running stitch	A sewing stitch where the thread is passed in and out of the fabric at an equal distance.
