People belong to and have different roles in groups such as:



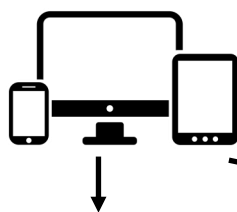
There are ways in which people are the same and different to others in their community, but they are all equal.
