Sundials were used to tell the time.

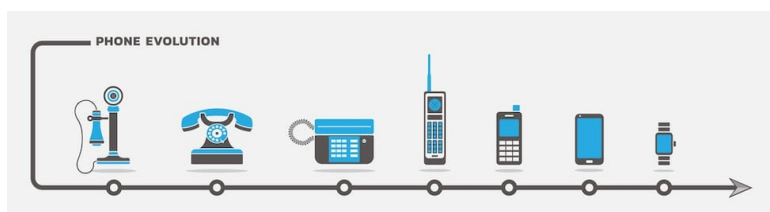
A sundial is an ancient invention.

We can look at objects from the past, look in books or use the internet to find out what life used to be like.






Lots of things were invented a long time again when Queen Victoria was the Queen.
