




Email


**Email's** are sent like letters. It allows people, who have an email address, to send and receive electronic letters. They usually deliver quickly and are free. You can send **emails** internationally quickly.

Computers whose one and only purpose is to send information to other computers are called **servers**, and the computers they serve are called **clients**.

When you open a webpage, your computer sends a message to another computer asking for the page, and that computer sends the page back. **Servers** therefore can be located across the planet.

Programmers write computer programs in a language we call **code**. This is when more than one **algorithm** is made and a script is formed from scratch blocks.

Block	Meaning
	This will start our game running. When the green flag is clicked all connected blocks will be run in order
	This creates a loop. Code inside is run over and over until the game is quit
	This is an if block. It checks whether something is true and if so, the code inside it is run
	This is a custom block and let's us create a procedure to call multiple times
	This block allows us to animate our character to walk
	This block goes inside an if block and allows us to check whether a key has been pressed
	This block allows us to move our character right or left (on the x axis)

**Outputs** are devices that feed information out of a computer. These are devices such as: a printer, speakers and a computer screen or monitor.
