

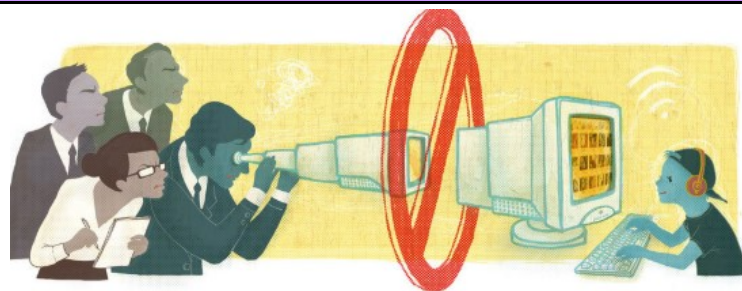
Year 4: Digital Literacy

The internet can be monitored at home, in school and in public. I know why this is necessary.

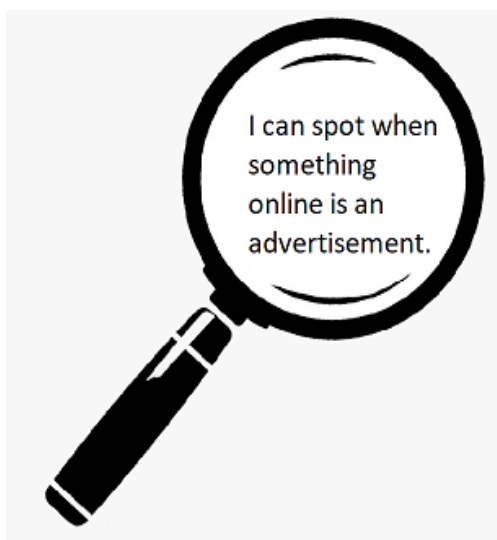


I know ways to keep my information online private and why this is important.

Parental control	When an adult can monitor your online activity or restrict parts of the internet
Fake profiles	When a person pretends to be someone else online
Online bullying	When someone is targeted and harmed by another online
