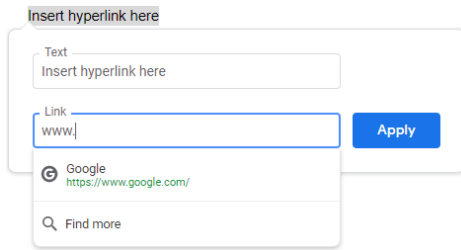

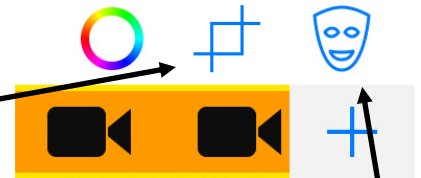
## Key Learning

Google Slides allows you to create an interactive presentation using media, animations, transitions and other effects.

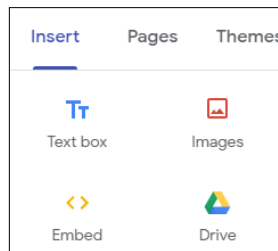
The Green Screen app allows clips and pictures to be **cropped** or **resized** to fit the task.



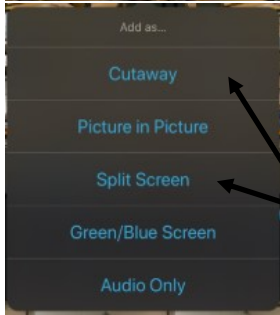
Experimenting with **additional tools** (green clothing & masking tools) allows you to see what difference you can make to your videos.



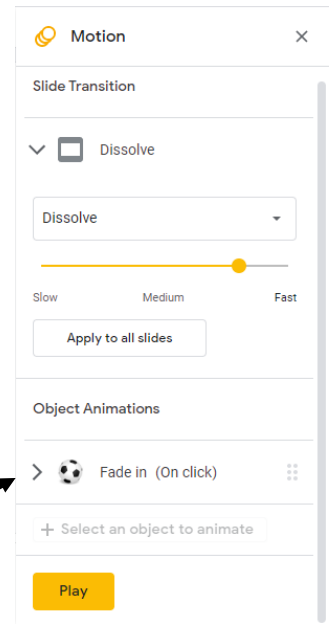
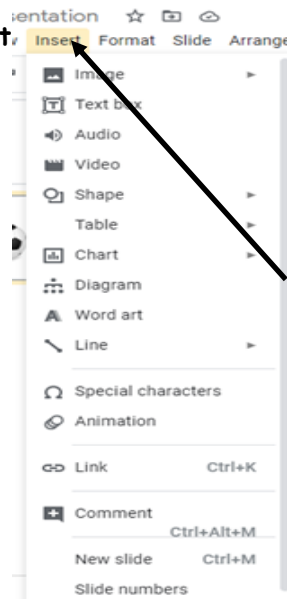
Google sites can be used to create a **webpage**.

To make a presentation interactive there are many effects which can help. Adding in media, animations, **transitions** and other effects.



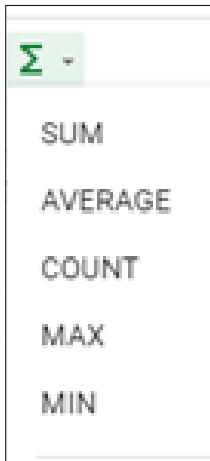
Even items on certain slides can have their own individual animation.

You can use **formula** to solve simple sums.

The **sum formula** will add up numbers in a number of **cells**.

The cells in the (brackets) are the cells that will be added together.

`=SUM(C2:K2)`



## Key Vocabulary

Split screen	A tool to play two video clips together, either side by side or one above the other.
Cutaway	A tool to play another video whilst the original clip is played as audio in the background
Transition	The movement between one slide to another in presentation software
Sum Formula	An addition formula performs a calculation using an addition rule (the sum)
Cell	A single location within a spreadsheet
Webpage	A hyperlinked site connected to the World Wide Web
Tools	Items used for a specific purpose when creating digital content
