What is

PREJUDICE

...an unjustified attitude towards an individual based on their membership in society.

DISCRIMINATION

STEREOTYPE

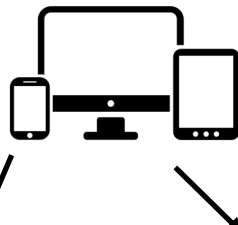
...an idea or belief many people have about a thing or group that is based upon how they look on the outside.

Images on the internet can be manipulated, altered or faked using editing software to make things appear different from their reality.

It is important to recognise stereotypes in different contexts and the influence they have on attitudes and the understanding of different groups.

People choose to communicate through social media to keep in touch with people, but this can come with some risks.

Some media and online content is not appropriate for children.

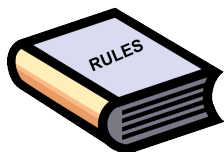
Content online can be designed to manipulate people's emotions and encourage them to read or share things.

There are common risks associated with money including:

- Fraud
- Gambling
- Debt



Companies encourage customers to buy things using offers and advertisements, so it is important to be a critical consumer.



There are rules and laws about sharing things online. People can get into serious trouble for sharing inappropriate content online.

If you see inappropriate content online or are contacted by someone inappropriately, you need to report it. You can tell a teacher, a parent or even the police.

Gaining or losing money can put people at financial risk by being stolen, through scams or gambling.
