Dear Parents and Carers

I received more updates from the government yesterday and last night and based on this I can provide you with some more information. I am sure that you will continue to have many questions and I will ensure that I provide more information as our plan develops. As you know, the government has asked us to plan for possible, partial re-opening on the 1st of June.

We have started that plan and I can confirm that we are planning to open for Nursery and Reception children and for children in years 1 and 6. We will also remain open for some vulnerable children and for children whose parents are key workers. (The list of key workers will not be changed or widened at this time).

Our main priority is the health and safety of your children and our staff! This means that we will be following the advice set out by the government for schools. This involves a series of measures that will limit any potential infection. This has been listed for us in order of priority:

- avoiding contact with anyone with symptoms
- frequent hand cleaning and good respiratory hygiene practices
- regular cleaning of teaching areas
- minimising contact and mixing

Team Moorside is working hard to develop an effective plan to reintroduce your children safely in Nursery, Reception, Yr.1 and Yr.6 back into school by June 1st. I will be communicating to you frequently to ensure that you are well informed and are up to date with our plan to achieve this effectively. I need to emphasise, at this point in time that, this is the Governments proposed plan and is very much dependent upon the continuing decrease in the infection rate.
