Dear Parents/ Carers,

As you have been identified as a key worker, provision from Monday 23rd March 2020 will be in place for your children if you require it, should there be no other alternative to keep your child/ren safe. Please be aware that should there be a need to, we will review our plan and it may become necessary to operate places at school on a tiered basis.

As I am sure you will understand, there will be a number of operational changes to the usual school day. These are essential to maintain the safety of all children during this time.

Passwords

Although the school already holds passwords for younger children, we will be required new passwords from parents/ carers of all children attending. Please send a password to the office Seesaw account. Any children without the password by Monday morning will not be able to access the provision on offer.

Entry and Exit

All children must enter the school building via the main school hall. There will be a staff member on the door taking a register of the children as they enter. Please do not leave your child/ren on the playground unless otherwise arranged directly with Miss Howarth, before midday on Monday 23rd March 2020. Children will then exit the premises via the same door at 3.15pm. Please note, the staff member on the door will be asking for passwords regularly, this is for your child/ren's safety. Should your child/ren be in Year 5 or 6 and you wish for them to walk home be themselves, please inform school.

Attendance

Normal attendance procedures will be in place. Therefore if your child/ren will not be attending we expect you to inform school using the usual channels.

Uniform

Children will not be expected to wear school uniform. They can wear their own clothes, however children will be engaging in outdoor games, forest school, arts and crafts etc.

Lunch

The school kitchen will be operating on a reduced menu. All children will have the option of a hot meal or a sandwich. Payment is via ParentPay as usual. Just to confirm, this service will continue during the Easter holidays.

Moorside Plus

It will be usual service at Moorside Plus, should you require before or after school club please contact Sandra directly on 07493 399626

In line with Government guidance should at any point during this time someone within your household develop Covid-19 symptoms, the whole family must immediately inform school and self-isolate for a period of 14 days.
