27th March 2020

7th April 2020

Dear all, I am writing to let you know that one of our key worker parents, with a child attending school over the last 2 weeks, has tested positively for C-19. This means there is a good chance that the child in question, who was not in yesterday, has also been exposed to the virus. The parent reports to be feeling fine but I wanted you to be aware of the case for your information. Unfortunately, we should not be surprised by this and nor will it detract from the work we are doing in providing means for the 'Front Line' to continue the vital job they are doing at this critical time. We continue to follow the government's advice in terms of medical safety at Moorside, and my fantastic and dedicated staff are being vigilant in terms of regular and thorough hand washing, observing the 2 meter's distance advice and avoiding cross contamination as far as possible. Our thoughts and prayers are with all those affected, Thank you Steve Lawler-Smith

13th April 2020

We have planned our staffing in light of the responses received and expected daily numbers, however this morning we have had some children arrive who we did not expect.
